

WELCOME TO THE LORD'S TABLE

At the time of the Distribution of the Eucharist, worshipers may use the bread and wine given out as you entered church this morning or come forward to the steps of the Chancel to receive the Sacrament by Intinction. Those worshipping at home via the live stream may use whatever bread and wine are at hand as the food of the Supper. Jesus himself used the leftover bread and wine from the Passover Feast to institute the first Eucharist. So we, too, may use those things closest to us for this celebration. Christians of any age or church affiliation are welcome at Christ's table, where Christ himself is the host.

All: **And also with you.**

One: *Open your hearts.*

All: **We open our hearts to you, O God.**

One: *Let us give thanks to God, an Abiding Presence.*

All: **To the one who companions us through all things,
we give thanks and praise.**
