Westminster Presbyterian Church is proud to celebrate Elizabeth Richmond, Director of the Westminster Community Center, on receiving the Marj Klise Community Action Award from the West Bluff Neighborhood Association. This award recognizes individuals whose dedication and service have made a lasting impact on the West Bluff community.

A longtime West Bluff resident and devoted member of Westminster Presbyterian Church, Elizabeth has spent years investing in the people and neighborhoods of Peoria. She was recognized for her vision and leadership in expanding Westminster's mission-centered outreach and creating opportunities that bring people together.

Among her many accomplishments, Elizabeth worked with community partners to launch First Fridays at Westminster Hall, a free monthly music series that showcases local artists while fostering fellowship and community. She also helped establish Second Tuesdays, an 'Open Mic Night' welcoming musicians of all ages and experience levels. Since their launch, these programs have become meaningful gathering places for neighbors from across Peoria.

Elizabeth has also led the development of Meet & Greet events for foster families, an Essential Items Supply Closet that provides needed items for children entering foster care, and weekly fellowship and educational programs for older adults in partnership with the Graceland Center for Purposeful Aging. Proceeds from these community programs help support the WestMark Food Pantry, extending Westminster's mission of caring for those in need.

In presenting the award, Elizabeth was recognized as a compassionate leader, creative problem solver, and tireless advocate for others. Her work reflects a deep commitment to building relationships, strengthening the community, and serving with humility.
